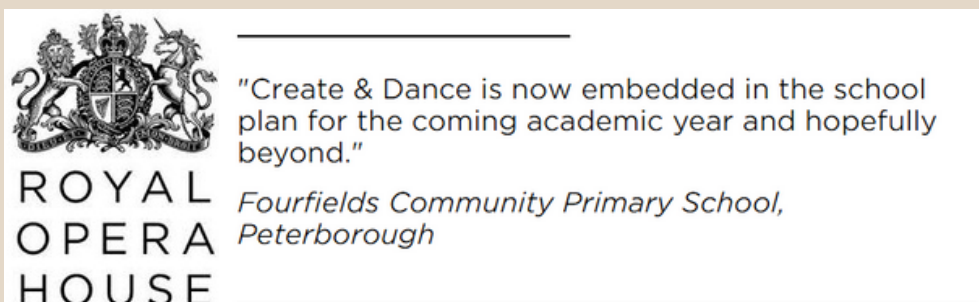

## Big Moves CPD Workshop (Primary Staff)

### Big Moves

Movement Intervention Programme for Primary School Children

In its final year of delivery by developer Elaine Cowley!

The BIG MOVES Intervention Programme has been created to help children in mainstream schools improve their physical development and has impacts on wider school life, including developing listening and concentration, learning success and appropriate behaviour.

Developed by Elaine Cowley- a Developmental Movement Practitioner, over a six-year period in a Leicestershire school, this programme is based on how the brain develops in early childhood and the foundation sensory and motor skills that every child needs to succeed in school and life. It explains the BIG MOVES every child has to experience in childhood before they can move on to using the small moves of the eyes and fingers for learning in the classroom.

Improvements noted from using BIG MOVES! include:

- Significantly raised value added scores in KS1
- Better listening and concentration
- Improved ability to follow instructions.
- Better posture, no longer slumping in the chair.
- More imagination & creativity
- Improved ability to sit still and less fidgeting
- More determination and ability to persevere.
- Less complaining of tiredness
- Improved pencil grip
- Improved handwriting
- Improved tool use, including safe use of scissors.
- Raised independence, including in writing
- Greater confidence
- Better vocabulary about their own bodies
- Self-organising
