PARALYMPIC LEGACY PROGRAMME



Celebrating the success of ParalympicsGB at the Paris Paralympic Games, we have delivered our Paralympic Legacy Programme in primary schools in Leicester City during the autumn term.

The programme involves 6 weeks of delivery and is targeted at SEND pupils to give them the opportunity to participate in various Paralympic sports. School staff were asked to support, which allowed them to use the programme as a CPD opportunity to improve

their knowledge and confidence in delivering inclusive sports.

16 pupils from Coleman Primary School took part in the programme during the autumn term and experienced various Paralympic sports, including Boccia, Archery, Sitting Volleyball and Blind Football. There were varying additional needs in the group, including; autism, hearing impairment, SEMH and sensory and physical needs.

The children progressed throughout each session, becoming more confident and knowledgeable of the sports and the techniques involved.

The school staff can now use their experience in the programme to extend the opportunity to additional pupils in the school through their extra-curricular provision.
